Vicolo Montepulciano d'Abruzzo DOC is sourced from vineyards located in the province of Chieti, around the coastal town of Ortona and south to the hilly area around Scerni on the Adriatic coast. The vineyards are about 281 meters above sea level providing the grapes ideal sun exposure and a microclimate tempered by the sea.

The wine is un-oaked to preserve its youthful, fruity characteristics.

Deep ruby color; the nose is plum fruit and earthy notes. Full bodied on the pallet with plum fruit, spice notes, and soft grape tannins with medium acidity. The pallet texture is soft making it approachable and versatile with or without food.

Available in 750ml and 1.5L sizes

Montepulciano, one of Italy's most popular red wine grapes, has thrived in Abruzzo since the middle of the 18th century. A plump grape that produces easy-drinking wine, typically deeply colored with low acidity and soft tannins.
